### RADBURN CITIZENS' ASSOCIATION MEETING

President Art Murray called the meeting to order.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Reading of minutes of the September and October, 2009 meetings was postponed as copies were unavailable for distribution.

Treasurer's Report was given by Marshall Chandler.

#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Art Murray

The annual members' meeting of the Radburn Association was held last Monday at Biagio's at which a proposed slate of new officers was selected with a vote to be taken at the January, 2010 Board of Trustees meeting. The slate consisted of Lou Weiss for President, Marion Paganello as Vice President and George Brouca as Treasurer.

Art Murray explained the Radburn Citizens' Association officers election for for Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, with David Rosenberg and Bart Spinelli running for Vice President, Marshall Chandler running unopposed for a second term as Treasurer and Eric Schutz running unopposed for his first term as Secretary. Outgoing Secretary Larry Koplik has completed the two term maximum. President Art Murray continues for the second year of his term. Art thanked all those for serving in their respective positions. The votes will be tallied by a committee consisting of Stu Golding, Joan Goldstein and Sue Fishbein.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

Phil Plotch reported on the status of the Radburn Democracy effort. On December 1 the Fair Lawn Boro Council will conduct an open public meeting on the subject of Radburn Democracy at which anyone will be able to speak. Following a period of consideration and deliberation, the Council will decide what position it will take, if any, and may vote on a resolution in January, 2010.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

Starting in January, Jane Alania has agreed with others to host a Friday Night at the Grange for Children event geared to children ages 3 to 11. In addition, Jane will start a Mommy and Me group at the Grange for 45 minutes on Monday mornings at 10:00 am. More information will follow.

The next RCA meeting time and place will be announced in the Radburn Bulletin for January 2010 when the schedule for the new year is established by the new leadership. Art Murray noted that going forward the Radburn Bulletin will be sent via first class mail in order to facilitate a timely arrival (i.e., prior to the events being announced therein).

The meeting was adjourned by Art Murray.

The election occurred immediately thereafter, continuing for the balance of the evening and producing Bart Spinelli as Vice President for his second term, Eric Schutz for his first term as Secretary and Marshall Chandler continuing for his second term as Treasurer.
