President's Report was delivered by June Meyerson as follows:

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

The annual Halloween Costume Party held at The Grange on October 26 was a huge success with over 100 participants of all ages sporting a wide array of clever and creative costumes. The many entertaining activities and games were well attended. Awards were presented for the particularly noteworthy costumes, as determined by a distinguished panel of judges. June Meyerson thanked all of the participants and the many volunteers who worked hard to decorate the gym and run the event.
