

Radburn Election Reform Proposal

1-Any person over twenty one residing in Radburn is eligible for candidacy.

2-Persons must supply a petition signed by fifteen qualified voters to qualify for a primary election to select the six people with the most votes to be on the ballot. Homeowners and renters will be eligible to vote, maximum of two per dwelling, no changes.

3-Three Trustees will be elected every year for three year terms to replace three trustees whose terms will end by the election date or soonest thereafter. Depending on the date of the initial democratic election some present trustees may serve a but more than three years to ensure an orderly transition. The Board will have nine Trustees.

4-The President of the Citiizen's Association will be elected separately for a three year term and will be a Trustee. That means that every three years two Trustees will be elected plus the President of the C.A.

5-If a Trustee is unable or unwilling to serve a full three year term the sitting and former Trustees will select a replacement to serve the balance of the term. Trustees must wait three years after their term before seeking candidacy again.

6-The Trustees will continue to select a Pres., Vice Pres., Secretary and Treasurer; no changes.

The intent of these recommendations is to provide for a democratic election process in lawful compliance and to make as few changes as possible since it is clear that there would be no movement for reform were it not for the sale of Daly Field.
