My family has lived in Radburn for over 15 years, and every year the neighborhood has gotten better; from the landscaping, the pools, the activities, the pre-school, the sidewalks and on and on.

When I was elected to the Board, I learned firsthand and was very impressed with how much hard work goes into the running of Radburn.

If the Board does not sell Daly Field, it will only be a matter of time before all of our Radburn charges increase tremendously in order to keep up with rising costs and aging assets.
